1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Overview

- 1.1.1 Yomojo is committed to protecting your child's privacy. This Children's Privacy Policy ("Policy") should be read in conjunction with our general Privacy Policy document. This Policy explains to parents and guardians ("Parent" or "you") how we collect, use and share personal information from users of our website ("Site"), our mobile applications (each, an "App"), and online services (collectively, the "Services") who are identified as under 13 years old (individually, a "Child", and collectively, "Children"), and how you may limit the collection, use and sharing of your Child's personal information.
- 1.1.2 This Children's Privacy Policy does not apply to users 13 years old or older; such users should refer to the general Privacy Policy available at <https://yomojo.com.au/terms>. Unless otherwise defined in this Children's Privacy Policy, capitalised terms will have the meanings set forth in the general Privacy Policy or the general Terms also available at <https://yomojo.com.au/terms>.

1.2 Note to Parents and Guardians

- 1.2.1 Our Apps and Services are intended for general audiences and do not knowingly collect any personal information from Children. If you indicate that your child is under the age of 13, your child WILL NOT be blocked from using our Services.

2 COLLECTED INFORMATION

2.1 Information Your Child Provides

- 2.1.1 In general, we do not collect personal information from your Child. We do not solicit your Child to contact us or provide us with personal information. If in the event that your Child does contact customer service, we will only collect the data included in that communication. We may also obtain information from other sources and combine that with information we collect on our Services.

2.2 Information Automatically Collected by our Service

- 2.2.1 When your Child uses our Services, some information is automatically collected, including but not limited to: device operating system, Internet Protocol ("IP") address, access times, browser type and language, and device identifier numbers, and list of installed applications.
- 2.2.2 We also collect information about your Child's usage and activity on our Sites. Additionally, if you authorise it, geolocation data may be collected, transferred, and stored as part of providing our Services. This is necessary to display your Child's device location to you.
- 2.2.3 Like many websites, our Site may automatically collect information using "cookies." Cookies are small data files stored on your Child's computer's hard drive by a website. Among other things, cookies help us improve our Services and your Child's experience. We use cookies to store user session data, remember your Child's account settings and determine if your Child's

computer system is compatible with certain technologies, such as Flash and JavaScript.

3 USE AND SHARING OF DATA

3.1 Use of Your Data

- 3.1.1 We use personal information collected through our Site, App and Services for purposes described in this Policy or disclosed to your Child on our Site, App, or in connection with our services. For example, we may use your Child's information to: (i) operate and improve our Services, Apps and Sites; (ii) understand you and your preferences to enhance your Child's experience and enjoyment using our Site, Apps, and Services; (iii) respond to your Child's comments and questions and provide customer service; and (iv) link or combine it with other personal information we get from third parties, to help understand your needs and provide you with better service.
- 3.1.2 From your Child's personal data, we may also create anonymous and de-identified data records so that may better understand usage of our Services and improve our offering. Yomojo reserves the right to collect, create, use and disclose anonymous and de-identified data records to third parties at its discretion.

3.2 Sharing of Personal Information

- 3.2.1 We do not share your Child's personal information with third parties other than as follows: (a) with the Parent's consent; (b) with third party vendors, consultants and other service providers who work for us and need access to your Child's information to do that work; (c) to comply with laws or to respond to lawful requests and legal process, to protect the rights and property of Company our agents, customers, members, and others including to enforce our agreements, policies and terms of use or in an emergency to protect the personal safety of Yomojo, its customers, or any person; (d) in connection with or during negotiation of any merger, financing, acquisition, or dissolution, transaction or proceeding involving sale, transfer, divestiture, or disclosure of all or a portion of our business or assets to another company; or (e) in the event of insolvency, bankruptcy, or receivership, your information may also be transferred as a business asset. Any acquirer of Children's personal information held by Company will continue to abide by this Children's Privacy Policy.
- 3.2.2 We may also share aggregated or de-identified information in our sole discretion.

3.3 Choices Regarding Personal Information

- 3.3.1 We provide Parents the following choices with respect to the collection, use, retention and disclosure of personal information. A Child's registration information is always accessible to him/her. A Parent has the right to review his/her Child's personal information, and/or ask us to update or delete the Child's personal information by contacting us at support@yomojo.com.au. A Parent may prohibit us from sharing a Child's personal information with a third party by requesting such prohibition by contacting us at support@yomojo.com.au. Notwithstanding any such requests, we may continue to share a Child's personal information with third parties for the purposes described in 3.2.

- 3.3.2 If a Parent chooses to prohibit any future collection, use or disclosure of the Child's personal information, the Parent may do so by terminating the Child's Services account on the Website and uninstalling the App. After receiving such request, we will delete the Child's account information from our live databases and all the information and data stored for such account. Yomojo will not have any liability whatsoever for any termination of the account or related deletion of the Child's personal information. When we delete personal information, it will be deleted from our active databases but may remain in our archives.

3.4 Security of your Personal Information

- 3.4.1 We are committed to protecting the security of your Child's personal information. We use a variety of industry-standard security technologies and procedures to help protect your Child's personal information from unauthorised access, use, or disclosure. While Yomojo uses reasonable efforts to protect your Child's personal information, no security measure is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee the security of your information.

3.5 Changes to this Children's Privacy Policy

- 3.5.1 This Children's Privacy Policy is subject to revision, and if we make material changes to our collection, use, or disclosure of Children's personal information, we will revise this Children's Privacy Policy to reflect those changes. We may from time to time use the Parent's e-mail address to contact Parents regarding this Children's Privacy Policy.
